HISD AFJROTC INSPECTION QUESTIONS

Answer all questions by repeating the question as part of your answer.....

DRILL

1. What does dress & cover mean?

Dress: alignment side to side with one arms length separation.
Cover: alignment directly behind the person in front with 40 inch separation

2. How many elements are in a flight?

At least two, but not more than four.

3. What is an element?

The basic formation comprised of at least 3, but usually 8 to 12 individuals.

4. How many steps per minute in marching?

Slow time 60 (funerals)
Mark time 100 - 120
Quick time 100 - 120 (12 or 24 inch steps)
Double time 180

5. What is the length of the pace in marching?

12 inch for half time (step)
24 inch for quick time
30 inch for double time

6. All marching movements begin on the left foot except . . .

Right step, MARCH and Close, MARCH

7. The space between individuals placed side by side is . . .

Normal interval: arms length
Close interval: four inches

8. What are the three types of commands?

Preparatory, execution, combined

9. Where is the Flight Sergeant's position in formation?

Last person in base element.

UNIFORM

10. Where is the insignia placed on the flight cap?

Centered top to bottom 1½ inches from front edge on the left side.

11. Where is the name tag worn on the service coat?

When worn, center metallic name tag on right side between the sleeve seam and the lapel. Bottom of name tag will be parallel with bottom of ribbons.

12. Where are ribbons worn on the service dress?

Grounded and centered on pocket

13. Where is enlisted grade insignia worn on the short sleeve shirt?

Worn on both collars, centered side to side, top to bottom, and parallel to the ground with bottom point of torch pointing toward the point of collar.

14. Where is enlisted grade insignia worn on the lightweight blue jacket?

Centered side to side 1 inch up from the inner edge of the collar and parallel to outer edge.

15. How do you earn an HISD DJROTC Citation Cord?

100% on uniform inspection and 100% on questions asked.

Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps
